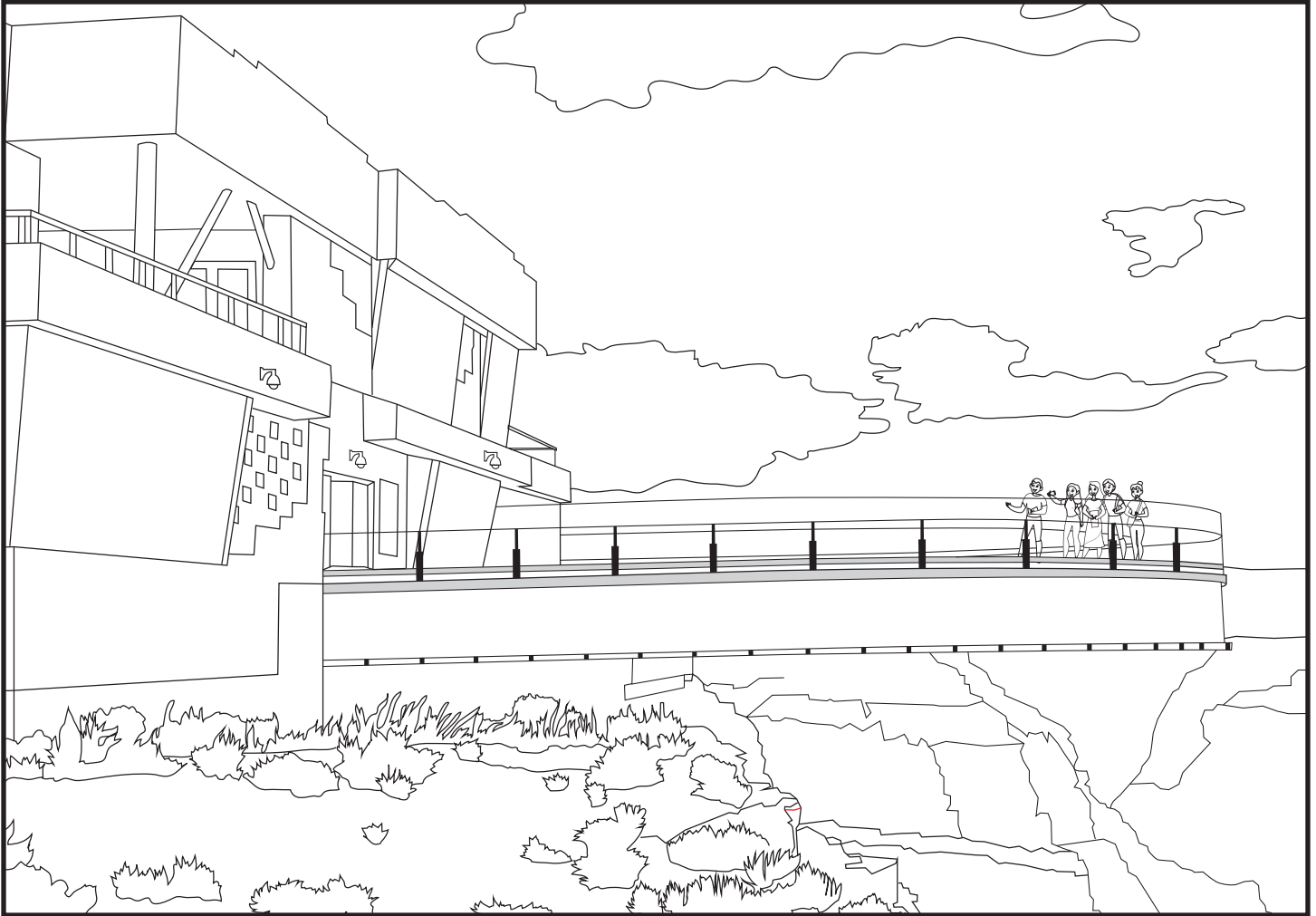


## THE GRAND CANYON WEST SKYWALK

## DID YOU KNOW?

The only place you can walk on the sky over the Grand Canyon West rim is at the engineering marvel called Skywalk.

- The Skywalk is the largest cantilever glass bridge in the world.
- The Skywalk is 4,000 feet above the Grand Canyon floor, almost twice as high as any high-rise in the world.
- The Skywalk is in a horseshoe shape extending 70 feet over the Canyon.
- The Skywalk is constructed of 46 panes of glass, each weighing about 1,800 pounds; combined with the other materials, the Skywalk weighs 1.2 million pounds.
- The Skywalk can withstand a magnitude 8 earthquake.
- The Skywalk is strong enough to hold seventy fully loaded 747 passenger jets.
- The Skywalk is on the Hualapai Reservation at Eagle Point in Arizona.
- The Skywalk was opened to the general public on March 28, 2007.
- The Skywalk has been profiled on the National Geographic Channel, The Today Show, and CNN.
