



GUEST APPEARANCE GUIDELINES

Welcome to the Hualapai Tribal Reservation, home of Grand Canyon West, a casual, family-oriented environment.

Grand Canyon West (GCW) reserves the right to exclude visitors who wear clothing that could create a distraction. This policy is in effect at all GCW viewpoints.

INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE

Attire that is not appropriate for GCW (and which may result in refusal of admittance) includes but is not limited to:

- ✓ Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics.
- ✓ Clothing made with offensive material, (i.e. transparent).
- ✓ Clothing that is excessively torn.
- ✓ Clothing which, by nature, exposes portions of the body that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment such as string bikini tops, G-strings, bikini bottoms, etc.

All GCW guests are required to wear shirts and shoes at all times. Swimsuit tops are allowed when worn with other appropriate clothing.

Most of the terrain at GCW is rugged. We strongly recommend wearing either hiking shoes or tennis shoes during your visit to prevent ankle injuries.
